SWIMMING

All Camp Rimon campers go swimming twice a week to an off-site pool. Campers have free swim supervised by lifeguards and Camp Rimon staff. Escalante Pool has been hosting our JCC campers for 30+ years. Older campers will swim at Kiwanis Pool. The pools are only open to our JCC campers during our swim time.

FIELD TRIPS

All Rimon campers will have weekly field trips, taking them all over the Valley as they explore museums, trampoline parks and so much more. In addition, Rimon campers will have special visitors.

CULTURE

An exciting part of the Camp Rimon program is how we infuse Israeli and Jewish culture into our programming, such as weekly Shabbat celebrations that include song, dance and challah baking. Campers will learn more about Israeli life, traditions, customs, food, its people, geography and so much more!

WHAT AGES ARE CAMP RIMON CAMPERS?

Camp Rimon is for children in grades K-6. A leadership program, the L.I.T. program, is for teens entering grades 9-10.

WHAT TYPE OF ACTIVITIES DOES CAMP RIMON OFFER?

No two days are alike at Camp Rimon! This summer, join us for our summer experience. Weekly activities include: swimming, music, arts & crafts, cooking, S.T.E.A.M. projects, field trips, sports, friendship-building activities, Shabbat celebrations and Israeli culture.

WHAT ARE CAMP HOURS?

The camp day is 9 a.m.-3 p.m. The day starts with a camp-wide opening and ends with a camp-wide closing session. Before-care is available 7-9 a.m. and after-care is available 3-6 p.m.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN CAMP RIMON REGISTRATION?

Swimming twice a week. Two snacks a day. Friday Shabbat fun. One free T-Shirt per camper. Weekly themed activities. Dress-up Spirit Days.

IS FOOD AVAILABLE FOR CAMPERS?

Kosher meals are available on Mondays (Baked Ziti), Wednesdays (Quesadilla) and Fridays (Pizza). Orders are due one week in advance for \$7.75 per meal (which include entree, fruit, vegetable and juice). Meals ordered after the deadline are \$11 each and are subject to availability. There is also a morning snack and an afternoon snack served, subject to the Chandler Unified School District schedule. Also available each week is challah and other baked goods. WHAT IS THE COST OF CAMP AND ARE SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE?

Camp is \$275/week (pro-rated for weeks with holiday closures). Before-care and after-care are \$55/week for each. Camp scholarships are available for families in need. The deadline to apply is Friday, March 27, 2025. Apply early, as funds are limited. Financial decisions will be made by April 30. Campers must be registered and scholarship applications must be complete to be reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis. Contact Sharon Bayer for more info at bayers@evicc.org.

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP & CAMP COMMUNICATIONS

Camp Rimon uses the JCC Early Childhood app for communicating with parents. Each family will receive an individual code to enter into the app on your smartphone and will give you the ability to sign in and out directly on your smartphone. This app also allows us to use electronic communications with parents, sign-in and out on your own device and receive reports and pictures from the counselors.

L.I.T. PROGRAM TEENS. LEADERSHIP. FUN. VOLUNTEER. GRADES 9-10

Our L.I.T.s (Leaders in Training) serve as leaders in our camp community and have opportunities to earn volunteer hours for school. Our L.I.T.s are trained in how to work with our younger campers and will lead and create camp programming. Cost is \$350 for the entire summer. Contact Stephania to apply, salvarez@evicc.org.
